Board of Governors AGENDA PROPOSAL Proposal: BOG 2019-001

- **Purpose:** To amend the BOG bylaws, approved at the Board of Governors meeting 2018 concerning electronic ballot voting for officers of the Board of Governors.
- **Proposal:** To amend the Blue Knights Board of Governors bylaws (Article 5: Voting Rights, Section 5B: Electronic Voting for Officers) addressing the electronic voting procedure for the election of the Board of Governors officers.

5 B) Electronic Voting for officers:

Which each Each Chapter President will have the ability of casting the ballot vote for the officers of the Board of Governors by secured electronic transmission voting. (Once allowed by Maine State law). That the balloting commence 30 33 days prior to the scheduled date of the election meeting and be completed at 0001 hours the day 3 days before the meeting (time is that of the scheduled meeting location). That the tally be secured till until the-commencement of the meeting and the written election tally be reported to the Secretary of the BOG (Emailed) to a BOG election committee which will be appointed by the BOG officers. No in person balloting for elections will take place the day of the scheduled meeting.

Background: As previous written there were two issues.

- 1. Emailing the results to the BOG Secretary would create a conflict of interest if the BOG Secretary was running for reelection. Forming an election committee (as is done for the International Executive Committee Elections) would address this.
- 2. BOG Annual Meetings are traditionally held the Monday Morning of the International Convention. Allowing voting until 0001 hours the day before the meeting would (as written) would mean the voting would end on Saturday night/Sunday morning. This would require the company handling the electronic election to have an employee work on Sunday to prepare and transmit the results to BOG Election Committee. Switching to "3 days" before the meeting would normally have the election end Thursday night/Friday morning and avoid the overtime costs of employees being required to work on the week-end. In the event the BOG Annual Meeting is moved later in the week, the election will still end 3 days prior to the meeting but the tally can be completed and reported after the weekend.
- **Intent:** To avoid any conflict of interest with the reporting of the results and to be more cost effective in tallying and reporting the result.
- **Advantages:** It will avoid any conflict of interest with the reporting of the results and to be more cost effective in tallying and reporting the result.

Disadvantages:	None.
